Final Assembly:

All engines are hot run under their own power. Oil pressure and cylinder compression is then checked and the cooling system pressure is tested prior to the cylinder head being re-torqued and tappets being reset.

Engine are then painted, sealed in polythene and bolted into a steel frame for UK delivery to your chosen address.

Surcharges: The surcharges are refunded upon receipt and inspection of your old engine. This can take on average 28 working days to process from the date your engine is collected. The surcharge will be refunded to your payment card and is on condition that your old unit is deemed serviceable. Engines deemed un-serviceable will not be eligible for refund of surcharges. Engine delivery cradles constitute part of the surcharge value and must be returned with your old unit in order to qualify for a refund.

The supply & fitment of a clutch will incur an additional charge on all engines **apart from** Stage II performance units.

Lead Times: Performance Engines – All performance engines are built to order. Once the order is confirmed and payment taken, build time is usually 3-4 weeks.
