FOLDING HOOD MIDGET 1967-79 (WITH ZIP OUT WINDOW)

Original equipment (O.E.) superior quality black vinyl hood, fitting the grey (early) or black (later) folding hood frame used on 1275cc Midgets and Sprites and 1500cc Midgets between 1967 and 1979. The hood described here has the additional, non-original (but very useful) feature of a zip out rear window, in similar style to that found on late 1970s MGBs.

All Club hoods feature padded and strengthened extra length valances for improved weathersealing and durability. The header rail is not included, but every possible fastener is factory fitted. Hoods are designed to ensure the easiest possible DIY fitment to your existing header rail and frame.

It is strongly advised to fit a new seal to your car's header rail during the hood fitment process. Also note that 1967-68 cars originally had an extra Tenax fastener on each side of the hood, where later cars used Velcro strip. Owners of these earlier cars should also order an extra two fasteners with their hood order, since the new hood is made to 1969 onwards condition.



Easy to fit. Fitting a new Midget folding hood is not the difficult task often rumoured. Using the Club's preferred 'no-glue' method, allowing adjustment of the hood on the header rail, a hood can be beautifully fitted in around 2 1/2 hours.

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS



Basic hand tools required. Craft knife, crosshead screwdrivers, flat bladed screwdrivers, pop rivet gun, electric drill and chalk. Additionally, fitting 'Durable Dot' press-on hood fasteners requires a medium weight hammer and either a centre punch or a punch and die set (available from MGOC Spares). Fitting 'Tenax' fasteners, if necessary, is easier with a Tenax key.
