



CARBON FIBRE SPEAKER CONSOLE PANEL MGB 1962-67

Make the radio speaker console in your 3 synchro MGB (i.e. 1962-67 models) a real feature of the interior with this carbon fibre insert panel. Crafted to fit perfectly in the console and making a great backdrop on which to show off the MGB's bright finish speaker grille and bezel, the panel is made from carbon fibre laminated weave through which light reflects, making the pattern appear alive beneath the surface. A polymer lacquer finish creates depth and sheen.

Note that the console itself, plus the speaker grille and bezel, are not supplied with the carbon fibre panel but are available separately - in fact, why not also go for the Club's own leather covered console, to complete the effect?

The carbon fibre speaker console panel is a perfect accompaniment to the Club carbon fibre dash, door cappings and door pulls - also looks great with a Club Classic leather panel kit or a full leather interior upgrade.



Easy to fit. The carbon fibre panel is clamped to the console by the speaker bezel, which fits to the console with four nuts and washers (don't overtighten the nuts and crack the console). It's easier to remove the console from the car to get access to the nuts - a very simple and quick operation.



Basic hand tools required. A small open ended spanner is required for the speaker bezel nuts, while a crosshead screwdriver will remove and refit the four console retaining screws.
