SEAT FOAM BACK MGA DELUXE

Superb reproduction of the original seat foam back (squab) as used in the Deluxe seats fitted as an optional extra in some later MGAs.

An absolute must when reupholstering seats with new Club covers - tired, compressed old seat foams would simply not do them justice and would fail to offer the correct support for the seats' occupants. Additionally, new foams match the profile of new seat covers, holding them smartly taut and helping to make the job of seat reupholstery that much easier.





Advanced skills required. Deluxe seats are very difficult to reupholster successfully - for example, a lot of trimming experience is required to correctly fit the separate back panel of the squab cover. If you are concerned by this (and you may well be), remember that the Club offers a range of new or exchange reupholstered MGA Deluxe seat assemblies as a far easier alternative.



Basic hand tools required. Deluxe seat covers are glued to the foam centres with upholstery adhesive and then mostly secured with clips (use a tack hammer), but the squab back panel is stapled with a staple gun to the wood backboard, under the piping line of the rest of the cover - difficult to get right.
