

## OCTAGONAL SPINNER WITH 'MG' LOGO

Top quality chromed octagonal spinner, available in RH side (LH thread) or LH side (RH thread) versions to fit on 12 or 8 threads per inch (TPI) wire wheel hubs, featuring embossed 'MG' logo.

12 TPI spinners are for use on all earlier wire wheel MGs: MGT Types (for which spinners with MG logos were standard fitment), MGAs, plus MGBs, Midgets and Sprites up to 1964 approximately. 8 TPI spinners are for 1964 approximately onwards MGBs, Midgets and Sprites, plus all wire wheel MGCs. If you have an MGB, Midget or Sprite from 1963-65, it is advisable to count the number of threads per inch on your splined hubs before placing an order.

Octagonal spinners were originally fitted to MGs shipped to countries where local safety regulations banned the use of spinners with projecting ears. However, from 1969 onwards their fitment was standardised across all models for all markets. Nowadays it's more often than not up to the owner's taste - the choice of style is yours!



*Easy to fit.* Just don't forget a little bit of grease on the threads and hub splines from time to time.



*Basic hand tools required.* Just the hammer and spanner from the car's tool kit - or alternatively an octagonal steel spinner remover (see recommendation below).
