



## 2 EARED SPINNER WITH 'MG' LOGO

Top quality chromed 2 eared spinner, available in RH side (LH thread) or LH side (RH thread) versions to fit on 12 or 8 threads per inch (TPI) wire wheel hubs, featuring embossed 'MG' logo.

12 TPI spinners are for use on all earlier wire wheel MGs: MG T Types (for which spinners with MG logos were standard fitment), MGAs, plus MGBs, Midgets and Sprites up to 1964 approximately. 8 TPI spinners are for 1964 approximately onwards MGBs, Midgets and Sprites, plus MGCs. If you have an MGB, Midget or Sprite from 1963-65, it is advisable to count the number of threads per inch on your splined hubs before placing an order.

2 eared spinners were originally fitted to MGs up to 1969 shipped to countries where safety regulations did not ban the use of spinners with projecting ears. Nowadays it's more often than not up to the owner's taste - however, checking local regulations may be prudent before ordering eared spinners to replace your octagonal ones.



*Easy to fit.* Just don't forget a little bit of grease on the threads and hub splines from time to time.



*Basic hand tools required.* Just the hammer from the car's tool kit, preferably with a 2 eared plywood spinner saver - or alternatively a 2 eared steel spinner remover (see recommendations below).
